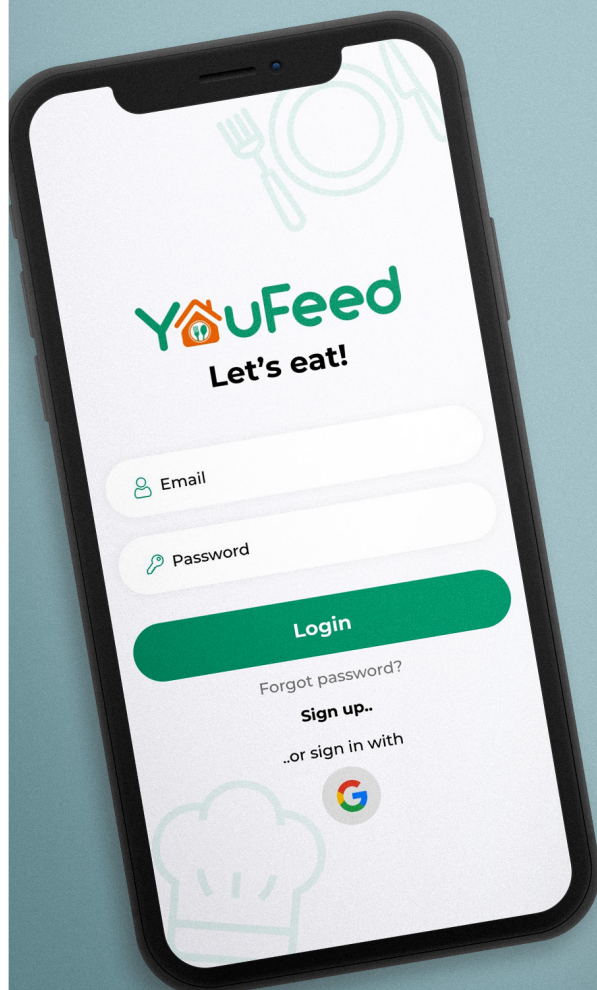

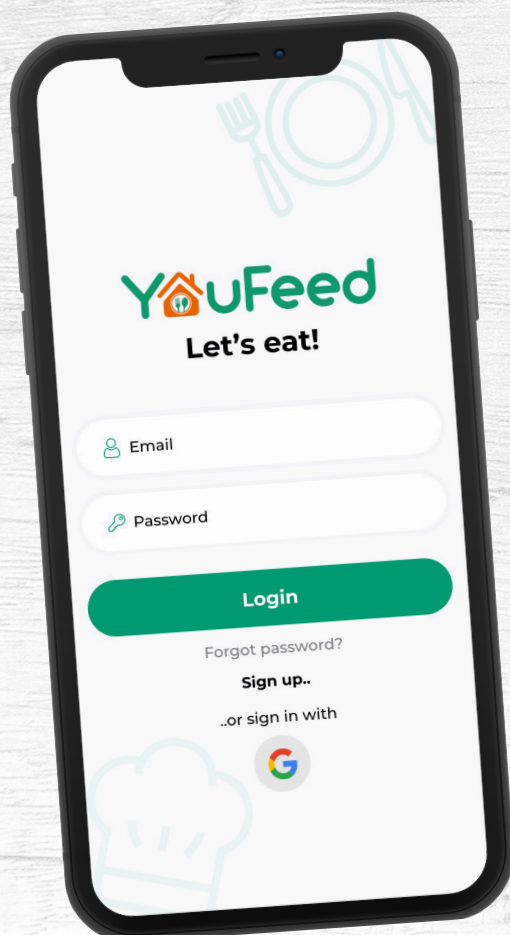


# There's a first time for everything

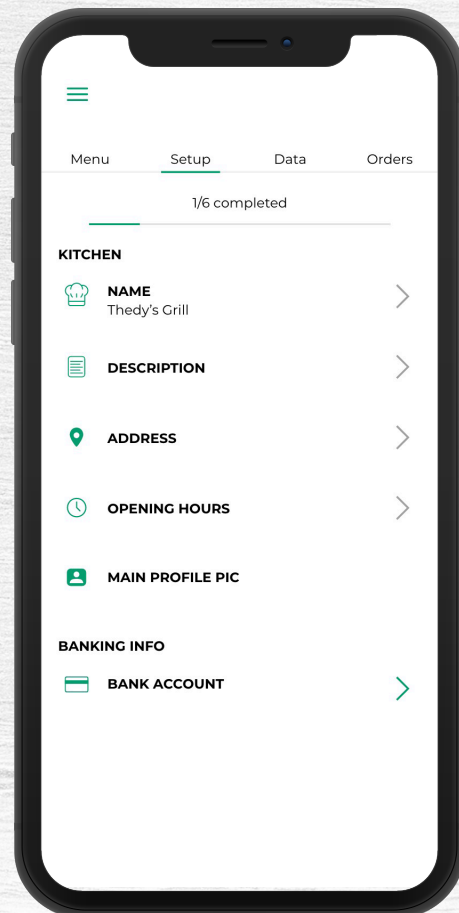


# Let's open your kitchen!

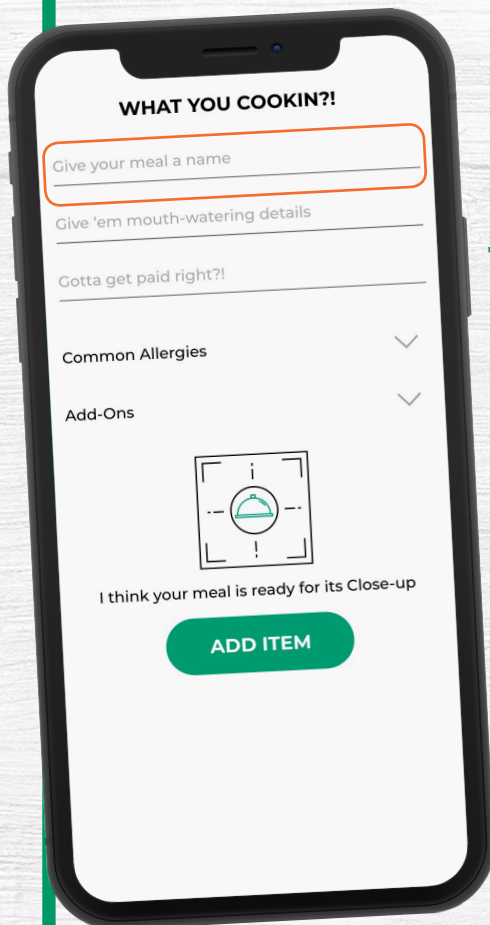

Let's add your first meal!



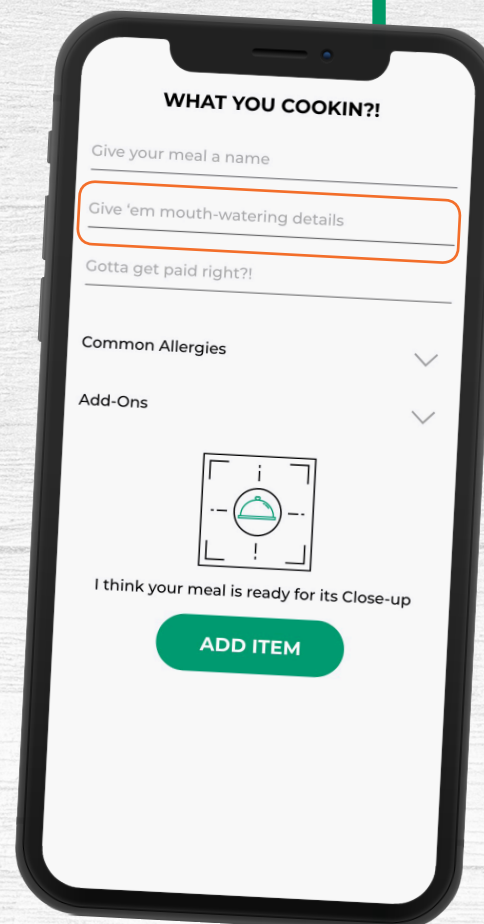
## Step 1

Start with naming your dish. Keep it short and clear. For example, "Seared Pot Stickers".

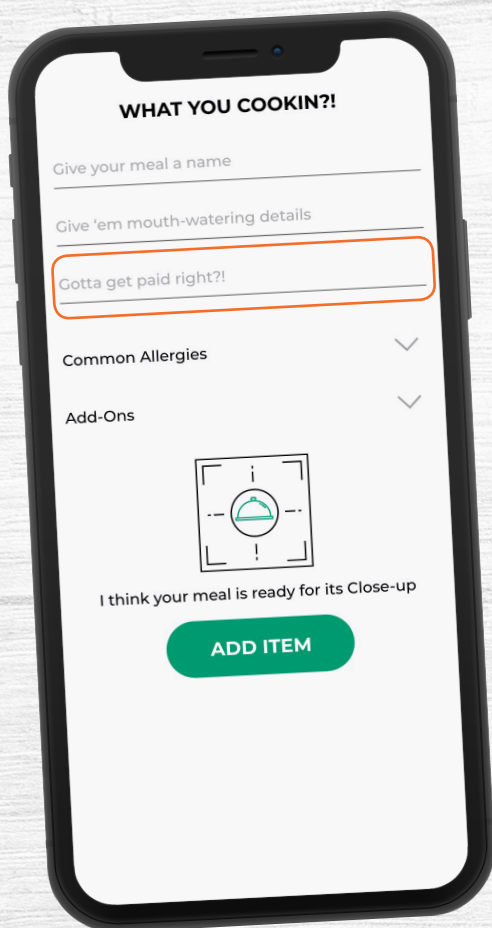
## Step 2

Describe each one of your dishes in a way that invigorates the senses and makes the customer visualize and crave your dish. Or you can keep it more simple but make sure to mention your unique ingredients. For example, *"Grilled ground beef kebab spiced with marash pepper, mint and oregano, smoked yogurt sauce, charred cucumber, herbs."*

Also list your ingredients. People want to know what is in the food they are eating. This is not only a health measure, but also adds credibility to your kitchen.





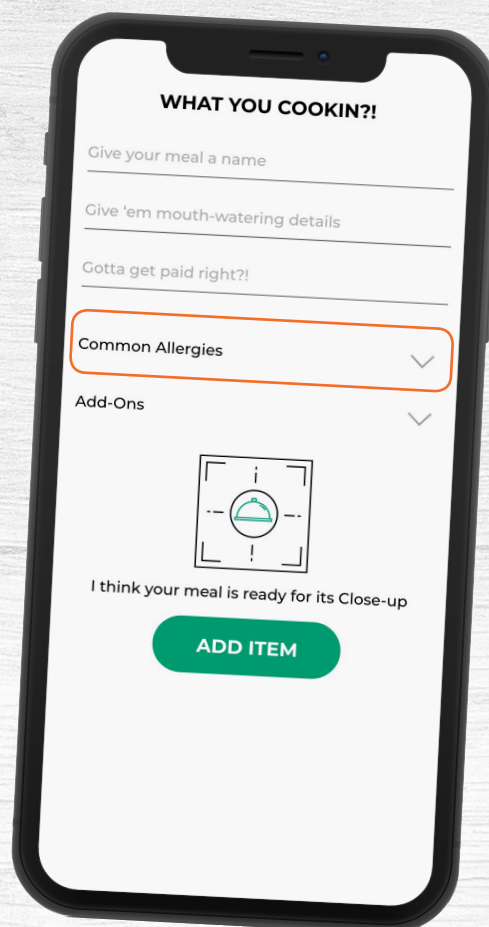


## Step 3

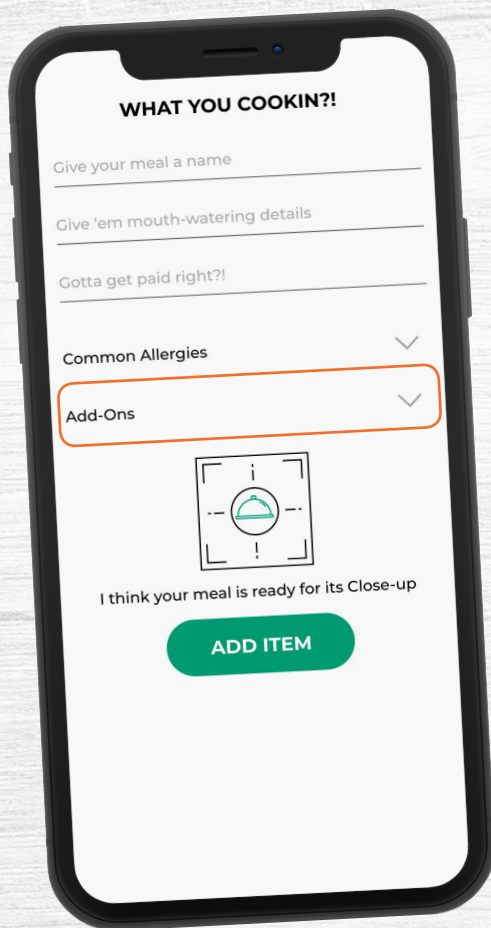
Set a price for your dish. Keep in mind your food costs, time and profit margin. Include any add-ons. Look at other kitchens to stay within a reasonable price range. Remember, you can always adjust your prices later.

## Step 4

It's important to list what possible allergies are taken under consideration in your dish. You don't want to cause an allergic reaction.





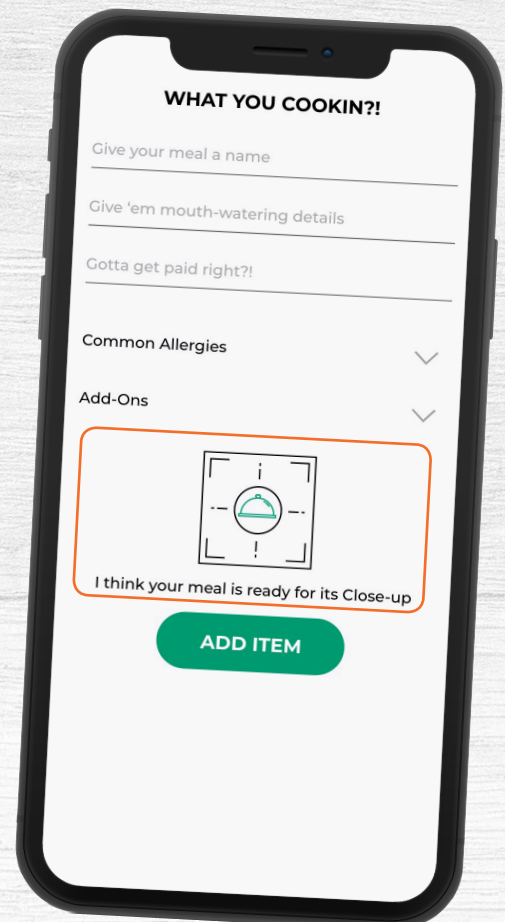


## Step 5

Make your meal complete by offering side items, such as a salad, soda, or French fries. Each add-on will be priced individually.

Capture photos of your dish. Your phone camera works fine as long as the picture quality is clear and bright. Try to be creative and work with good lighting and background. Essentially, this is your product. Not only is food taste important but their presentation goes a long way in attracting customers.
